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# Do You Have a Giant in Your Life?

Do you have a giant in your life – a circumstance or situation that looks bigger than you? Something that seems like it just won't change or shift? Something that makes you feel stuck or afraid?

If you are a believer in Jesus Christ, then you are called to be a giant slayer. You are called to be that person that the enemy dreads! Giants can be all sorts of things in your life. It can be finances or debt, it can be *family issues, addiction*, it can be *sickness*, it can be a *ruling, territorial spirit*, over a city, over a nation, it can be *depression*, a spirit of *fear or anxiety*, it could even be a spirit of *slander*. Giants always try to intimidate you, **they don't go away until you face them head on.**

Whatever giant you are facing, let me encourage you, men and women of God, **you are bigger than any giant you face.** You are taller than any walls that try to entrap you. You can be so full of faith, so full of the power of God's word and the life of his spirit, that no giant can tower over you! Let me tell you something, the only people who slay giants are those who know that they themselves are giants! Recently, God has downloaded me with several keys to slaying every giant that you face! These keys will help you turn the enemy back on his heels!

# Key #1: Know Your Power

Greater is he who is in you than he who is in the world! Your God has more power than the god of this world. It's all about our perspective. David didn't see Goliath compared with his own stature, but he measured Goliath up to the stature of God! When you compare your giant with the might and power of the creator of the universe, there is just no comparison!

Just think of how big God is compared with any enemy you may face - poverty, sickness, depression, anxiety, fear, manipulation, control, witchcraft, loss, pain... even the enemy himself!! Omnipotent. Omnipresent. Omniscient. He is all-powerful, all-present, and all-knowing.

## **Decrees:**

- I decree that my soul, mind, and body are aware of the greatness and power of God
- I decree that God is faithful to accomplish the word that He sent forth in my life
- I decree that I am an overcomer by the blood of Jesus Christ

# Key #2 - Know Your Covenant

When David faced up against Goliath, he knew that he had a covenant with the living God, and Goliath did not. Jesus died on the cross to give you the victory, but you have to really know that in your heart. You have to understand that God destined you for greatness, he destined you for victory!

1 Samuel 17: 26

Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, *“What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?”*

Can you believe that when others heard it, including his brothers, they approached him with sarcasm and envy? Like, "What do you think you're doing?" But David knew that the Philistines had no covenant with God! No covenant = no favor. No covenant = no power. No covenant = no protection!

In the book of numbers, Joshua and Caleb explored the land flowing with milk and honey.

Even though their companions feared the giants, saying, 'We were like grasshoppers in their sight,' But Joshua and Caleb said, *"We are well able to take the land."*

Numbers 13:9 - *"Only do not rebel against the Lord, nor fear the people of the land, for they are our bread; their protection has departed from them, and the Lord is with us. Do not fear them."*

## **Decrees:**

- I decree that I am in covenant with the living God, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob
- I decree that I have access to the power of God to effect victory in my life
- I decree that I am walking with the awareness of the covenant I am in with God
- I decree that no enemy carries the same covenant and authority that I carry through the blood of Jesus

## Key #3 - Ignore the Naysayers!

### 1 Samuel 17:28

*“Now Eliab his oldest brother heard when he spoke to the men; and Eliab’s anger was aroused against David, and he said, “Why did you come down here? And with whom have you left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know your pride and the insolence of your heart, for you have come down to see the battle.”*

**1 Samuel 17:33:** *“And Saul said to David, “You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him; for you are a youth, and he a man of war from his youth.”*

There will always be voices, whether in the natural, or the voice of the enemy, which will try to convince you that nobody has ever taken on this enemy before.

Voices will tell you that people better equipped than you haven't even been able to accomplish this, that people stronger than you, more experienced than you weren't able to do it, so there's no way someone like you will be able to do it!

There will always be voices that try to discourage you. Listen, child of God, the only voice that you should be listening to is the voice of the Holy Spirit, the spirit which leads into all truth!

This year, I declare that you will succeed in all your endeavors! You are free from the bondage of the enemy, and the chains of intimidation are broken off of your life! May new winds be assigned to your life, winds of acceleration, winds of peace, and winds of change! **Isaiah 43:19** says, *“Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.”*

## Decrees:

- I decree that I have the mind of Christ
- I decree that no voice will have influence over my mind, will, & emotions but the voice of God
- I decree that I have faith for the task, no matter how big it seems to me!

## **Key #4 - Put on God's Armor, not Saul's**

*1 Samuel 17:38 - So Saul clothed David with his armor, and he put a bronze helmet on his head; he also clothed him with a coat of mail. David fastened his sword to his armor and tried to walk, for he had not tested them. And David said to Saul, "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them."*

So David took them off. It may seem as if you are ill equipped compared with the people around you and their devices. Other people may have more connections than you, they may have more experience, or more credentials than you. They may have more money than you, they may even have a smoother tongue than you do. Never forget that prayer, praise, worship, and most importantly, the word of God are your biggest weapons.

When David faced up against Goliath, he hurled stones at him. Stones represent the word of God. Take hold of the sword of the spirit. Listen to me, this is your giant slaying weapon! Jesus used scripture when confronted by the enemy in the desert. The word of God in your mouth is the most powerful weapon known to man, it will dismantle every attack of the enemy.

Jesus illustrated time and time again, the need for speaking to mountains, speaking to trees, speaking to sicknesses, speaking to storms, and you need to start speaking to giants in your life, speaking to giants of debt, cursing those things, reducing them to nothing, speaking to sickness, decreeing that no weapon formed against you shall be able to prosper!

You've got to understand that David was raised up as a symbol of the kingdom, he represents an eternal priesthood, the government of God; he is the pattern of the kingdom, of the lineage of covenant. God has removed the priesthood of Saul, the arm of the flesh. Saul stood a head above everyone else; he walked right, looked right, talked right. Just because something looks right, doesn't mean it is right! God removed a day of operating out of the flesh.

He had already been anointed as king, but he was not yet appointed as the king of Israel. He had not had that promotion to the actual promise yet. But he still acted like the king, he still took that stance of authority and power, wielding the name of God like a sword.

It was this act of faith that propelled him into the journey towards his destiny. Now, the Bible calls us kings and priests. We have that same level of authority to wield the name of Jesus over our enemies and our circumstances. Wherever there's a promise, there is a time of contention.

David fought for his destiny. God spoke a promise; there was a commissioning, there was an ordination and an anointing by the Prophet Samuel. But following that God-ordained commissioning, there was also a time of contention. Just because he was anointed as king, didn't mean that he was ready to step into the fullness of his calling.

Destiny is birthed by NOW faith!

### Hebrews 11:1

*“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, and the evidence of things not seen. (3) Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.”*

The writer of Hebrews here is referring to faith as that substance which brings us into realities that have not occurred yet, those realities which still lie in our future, in our destiny, in our imagination. Destiny is something that is not tangible, destiny is our journey in this life.

It takes NOW faith to bring us into that destiny, into that calling that God has placed on our life.

Faith operates on a higher plane and dimension than the laws of matter space and time, the laws of this natural universe. Faith is based on truth, not fact. There is a difference between truth and fact. Truth relies on the word of God, it is based on heavenly laws, not earthly ones. Truth is based on the laws set forth by God's word.

Fact is based on earthly standards, it is subjective. But truth abides by God's word and it never fails. The fact may be that you have a symptom of sickness, but the truth is that by his stripes, ye were healed!

## Decrees:

- I decree that I am clothed in the infallible armor of God
- I decree that in my mouth there's a sword, and that is the word of God!
- I decree that I am walking in NOW faith - faith that takes me into my destiny!

## **Key #5 - Relationship in the Secret Place Brings Favor for Public Victory**

David not only faced the Philistine in public, with boldness, but he was filled with faith from the time he spent in the secret place. David spent time in prayer, in intimate communion with the Lord, private time in prayer and worship in the fields with His sheep. He fought the lion, the bear, and finally, he was ready for Goliath.

The secret place brings favor! It will cause you to win the battle and it will cause promotion for your destiny! Don't expect a public victory if you haven't first worshipped in private - worship is your greatest warfare!

You are ready - go and fight your battle! Know your power, know your covenant... Don't let any negative voices influence your faith... Put on the full armor of God, and **PUSH!** Pray until something happens!

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
